The Ontario Trillium Foundation, an agency of the Ministry of Culture, receives \$100 million annually from Ontario's charity casino initiative.

Leonard Bernstein’s *Chichester Psalms* is a challenging choral work, commissioned for the 1965 Southern Cathedrals’ Festival at Chichester Cathedral. It has been described as one of Bernstein’s most exhilarating scores. Some material for this work was actually recycled from a musical that Bernstein never completed, *The Skin of Our Teeth* (based on the play by Thornton Wilder), and from early sketches of *West Side Story*, which was initially to have involved a Jewish-American gang.

That’s the Bernstein part of this Spring concert. To discover just how we manage to take you from “Bach to Bernstein”, you’ll have to join us at the concert!
